



# Eppley Airfield North Hangar Snack Bar

Omaha, NE

The Eppley Airfield North Hangar Snack Bar was designed to resemble the old-time hangars. The former snack bar was undersized for the demand. The food and beverage options and seating were very limited, and were not meeting passengers' needs. The new hangar-designed snack bar was relocated to the middle of the concourse, freeing up necessary space for the snack bar, as well as seating at the gates.

The design and location of the North Hangar were carefully planned to allow customers to enjoy refreshments, watch TV, use pay phones, etc., and still be able to see and hear all airline activity. Hot-dip galvanized steel was specified for all the structural framing because of its longevity and maintenance-free aspects. Additionally, the visual appearance of galvanized steel contributed to the old hangar look of the snack bar. With the maintenance-free galvanized coating, the North Hangar will be available for passengers' convenience without interruptions for generations to come.
