In the past, the Modular Road Salt Spreaders have always been painted, which resulted in a very short service life, high maintenance costs to continuously combat corrosion, and very unpleasant aesthetics, even after only one year of service. This product is an example of how larger galvanizing baths are creating important new markets.

The choice of hot-dip galvanizing was eminently logical from an economical point of view. This equipment is used in the worst possible winter conditions with constant attack from pure calcium and other aggressive de-icing chemicals. Alternative base materials such as stainless steel and aluminum cost far more relative to benefit, and can create undesirable corrosion cells within the truck itself.

With all the press about our crumbling road infrastructure and the huge sums earmarked to rebuild them, the salt truck is emblematic of the corrosion problem. To see them now galvanized speaks volumes about the performance of galvanizing for all kinds of roadway structures and accessories. "If it's good enough to protect the source of all these corrosion issues, imagine how well it will do elsewhere."
